1: How to use your Travelers Cheques

- **Immediately sign** each Cheque in the top left corner to help protect yourself in case of loss or theft.
- **Keep separate.** Keep your Cheques' serial numbers with you when you travel, but keep them separate from your Cheques.
- **Safeguard** your Travelers Cheques as you would a like amount of cash.
- **Countersign.** When you are ready to use your Cheques, countersign each Cheque in front of the teller or cashier.

2: Where to use your Travelers Cheques

You can either:

- **Exchange** your Travelers Cheques for local currency in your destination, or
- **Use** your Travelers Cheques to pay directly for goods and services at accepting retailers, restaurants, and hotels.

3: Exchanging your Travelers Cheques for local currency

There are thousands of banks and foreign exchange locations in countries around the world where you can exchange your Travelers Cheques for local currency.

- Photo identification may be required.
- We strongly recommend you retain and carry your original purchase receipt with you when you travel.
- Commission charges may apply and can vary by country or exchange partner.
- Exchange limits may apply due to local regulations and exchange policies.

4: Using your Travelers Cheques to pay for goods and services

You can use your Travelers Cheques like cash to pay directly for products and services at accepting retailers, restaurants, and hotels.

- Photo identification may be required.
- We cannot guarantee that all places accept Travelers Cheques as a form of payment.

5: For refunds and customer service

- You encounter an issue while trying to use your Cheques
- A service provider is unfamiliar with how to accept your Cheques
- To obtain a refund for lost or stolen Cheques

When exchanging foreign currency Travelers Cheques into local currency, some institutions may offer a commission-free service, however exchange rates may be applied and can vary by location. For example, you may not be charged a commission to exchange US Dollar Cheques into Canadian Dollars in Canada, however there may be an exchange rate applied to the transaction.

1. This list is subject to change without prior notice from American Express. Not all branches of the institutions listed have exchange services and services may vary by location. Please check with the institutions regarding applicable exchange rates and/or commission charges.
2. Please call to verify hours of operation and exchange policies prior to arrival. Charges, limits and conditions (including customer identification documentation required) to exchange your Travelers Cheques will vary depending on applicable law and institution policies. American Express cannot guarantee that all merchants accept Travelers Cheques as a form of payment.
